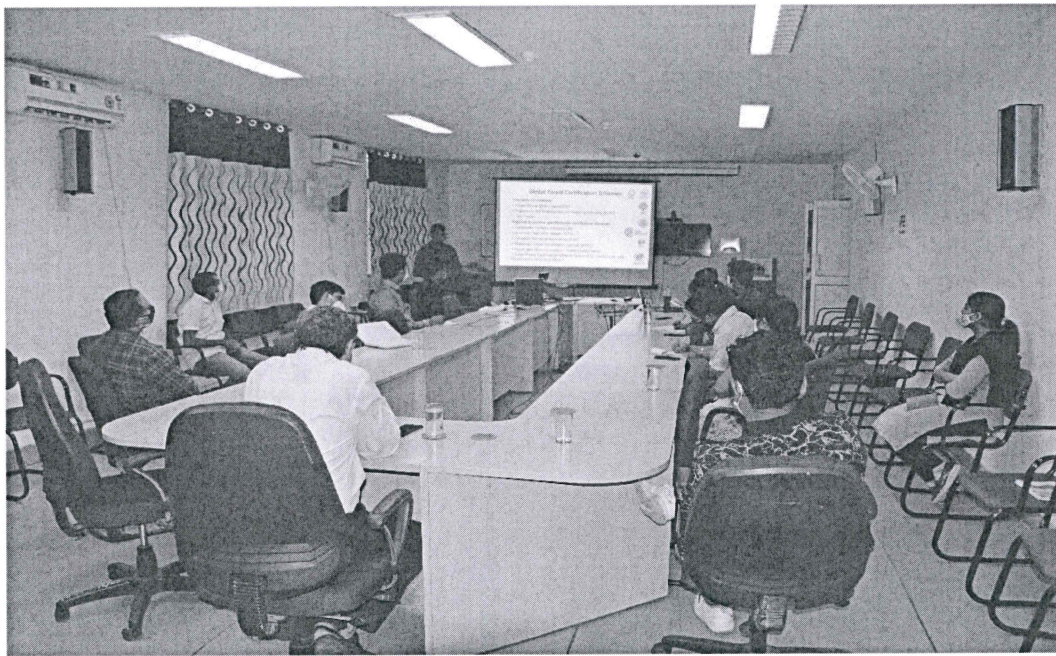

A seminar was held on the topic "**Forest Certifications**" on 24th August 2021 as part of the Monthly Seminar in the conference hall of the Institute of Forest Biodiversity, Hyderabad. 
