ICFRE-INSTITUTE OF WOOD SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY, BENGALURU

Institute of Wood Science & Technology (IWST), Bengaluru, one of the Institutes of Indian Council of Forestry Research & Education (ICFRE) was established in 1988. Earlier, the then Government of Mysore had set up a Forest Research Laboratory (FRL) at Bengaluru in 1938. In the initial years, work carried out mainly on properties and uses of different timber species, essential oils, other non-wood forest products and protection of wood and trees from pests and diseases. In 1956, this laboratory was organized as a regional centre of Forest Research Institute and Colleges, Dehradun. In 1977, Sandal Research Centre was set up to undertake research on wideranging aspects of Genetics, Silviculture and management of sandal. The Institute is presently catering the need of research and training in various aspects of wood science for Industries, Public and other Stakeholders.
