Awareness Program on Forestry and Wood Science at Institute of Wood Science and Technology, Bangalore

PRAKRITI Program is an agreement through a Memorandum of Understanding signed between The Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE), Dehradun and Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS), Navodaya Vidyalaya (NVS) and Directorate of Education to promote awareness about forests and environment among school children for acquiring skills that reflect care and protection towards forests, environment and society.

During the month of Sept 2019, a total of 86 students and 4 faculty members visited the institute under Prakriti Program.

In very simple terminology, the students were briefed about the activities of the institute and the work carried out in different divisions. A documentary on the same was also screened for the benefit of the students. They were explained about ill effects of deforestation and the importance of environmental conservation. The children were administered an oath to grow trees, avoid plastic and save the environment. They then visited the plant nursery, shade net house and greenhouse. The students were explained all about WOOD at the state of the art Wood Museum cum Interpretation Centre.

To top it all, the students were given a glimpse of natural forest through a nature walk in the 25 acres campus which is the right place for forestry learning with 10 acres of natural forest that is well preserved and maintained with a pathway through the forest thus giving children an opportunity to experience, enjoy and understand the beauty of nature and at the same time actually see some of the rare trees, birds, flowers etc. and learn about them.

At the end of the tour the students expressed that they enjoyed the nature walk and the serene location the most. Even the faculty were impressed as they could actually see trees of many different species. Both the students and faculty expressed that the visit was worthy.
