Forest Research Centre for Bamboo and Rattan (FRC-BR), Bethlehem Vengthlang, Aizawl, Mizoram hosted a one day Stakeholders Consultation Meeting for Integration of REDD+ in the Land Use Planning Activities in the State of Mizoram on 17.12.2019. The was meeting was jointly organized by Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE), Dehradun, Environment, Forests and Climate Change department, Govt. of Mizoram and International Centre for Integrated Mountain Development (ICIMOD), Kathmandu.

Sh. T. J. Lalnuntluanga, Hon'ble Minister of State, E, F & CC, Govt. of Mizoram graced the occasion as chief guest. Delegates of the meeting included forest department, agriculture department, horticulture department, land resources department, Mizoram REDD+ core team members, Mizoram University professor, Environmental NGOs, Farmers' Association etc. Dr. R. S. Rawat, ICFRE attended the meeting via video conferencing due to the cancellation of flight.

Inaugural session commenced by the formal welcome of Sh. T. J. Lalnuntluanga, Hon'ble Minister of State with a bouquet of flower. Delegation of ICIMOD was formally welcomed and felicitated by Sh. T. J. Lalnuntluanga, Hon'ble Minister. Dr. Bhaskar Karky, ICIMOD formally welcomed all the delegates in his welcome address and also mentioned the background of REDD+ activities in Mizoram. Dr. R. S. Rawat delivered his address to gathering via video conferencing. Sh. Liandawla, PCCF, Mizoram addressed the gathering and expressed the importance of REDD+ activities in the context

of Mizoram. Dr. K. Kire, APCCF, Mizoram gave a short presentation on SRAP-Mizoram.

Sh. T. J. Lalnuntluanga, Hon'ble Minister started his address by defining the concept of REDD+ under UNFCC. He mentioned that Mizo people depend upon forests for livelihood & food security and expressed his concern on the pressure on forests due to shifting cultivation, uncontrolled fires, unregulated felling, changes in land use pattern etc. He, then, commended the achievements of the Trans-boundary REDD+ Himalaya project which was jointly implemented in Mamit district of Mizoram by ICFRE, ICIMOD and Mizoram forest department. He further commended the efforts of ICFRE for developing Mizoram State REDD+ Action plan which will be helpful in implementation of the National REDD+ Strategy in the state. As a closing remark to his address, he congratulated the FRCBR, Aizawl for organizing this stakeholders consultation meeting and wished success for the same. After his address to the gathering, Hon'ble Minister formally released the Mizoram State REDD+ Action Plan (SRAP) document. Also, since it was his maiden visit to FRC-BR office, Hon'ble Minister inspected the campus and apprised himself of the past and current research activities of the centre.

After the inaugural session was over, technical session commenced and it included presentations from ICIMOD team and Director, Land resource department, Govt. of Mizoram. Also, delegates of the meeting participated in group exercise in the post lunch session.
